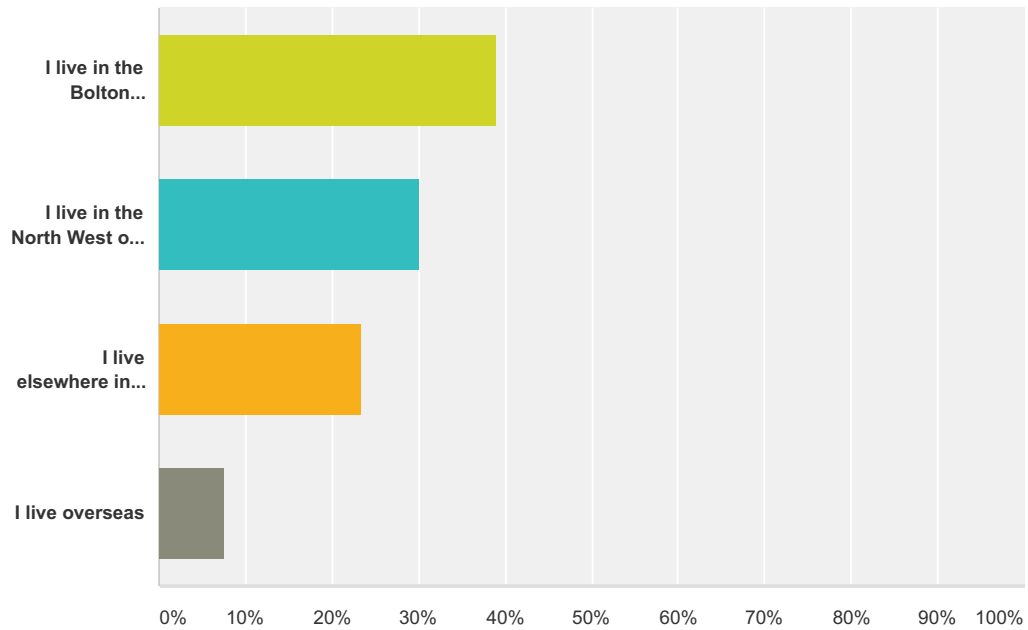


Q1 Which of the following best describes where you are living at the moment?

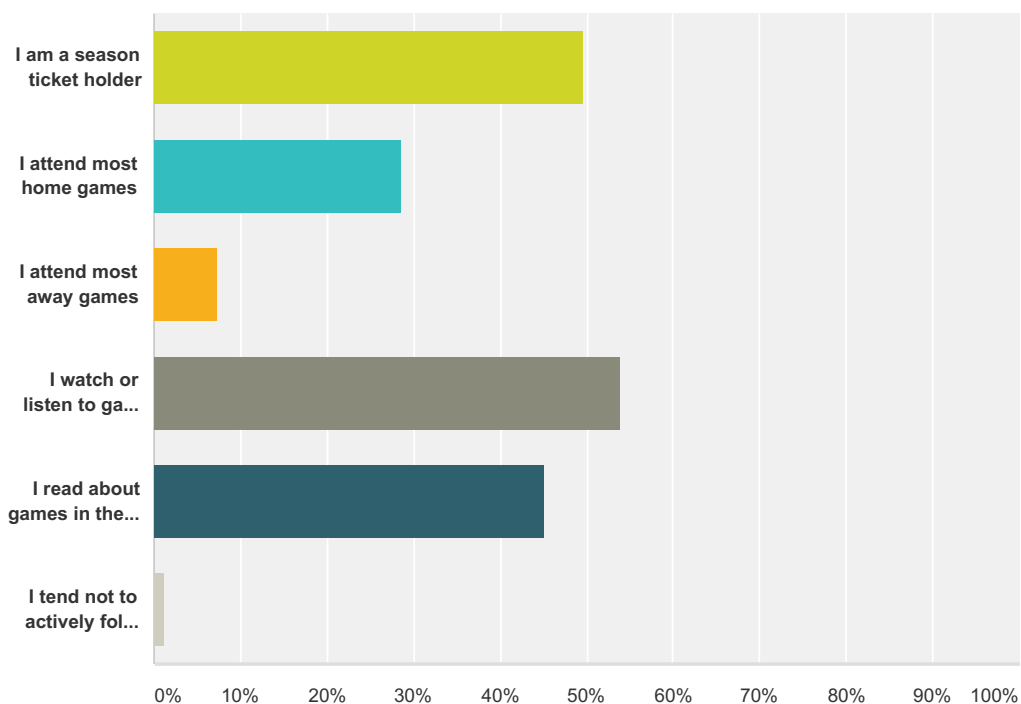

Q2 Which of the following best describes how you normally follow BWFC? (tick as many as appropriate)

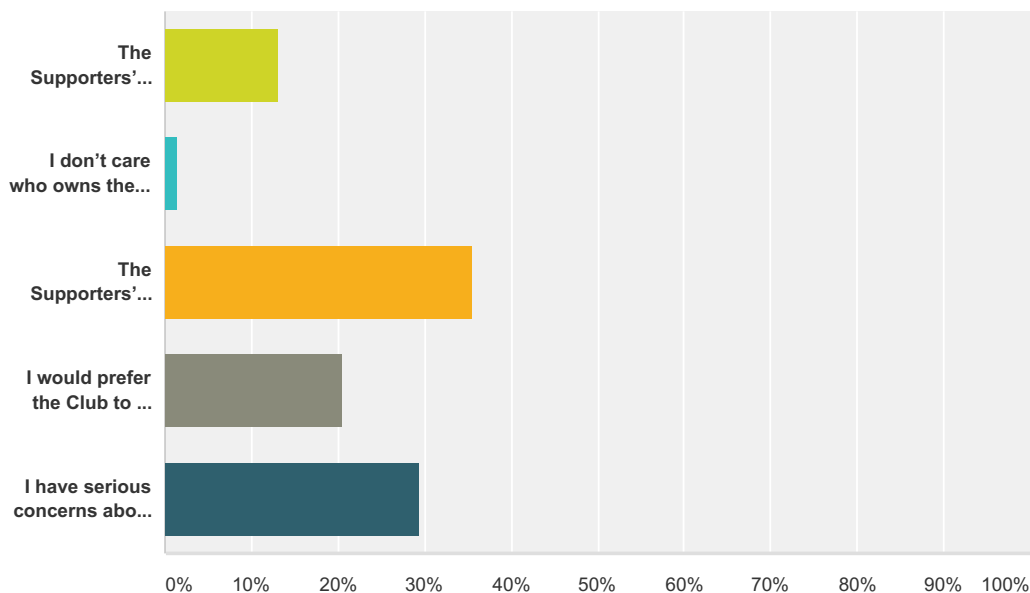

Q3 With the Club having a new owner please choose the statement that best describes your preference for the role & stance of the Supporters' Trust

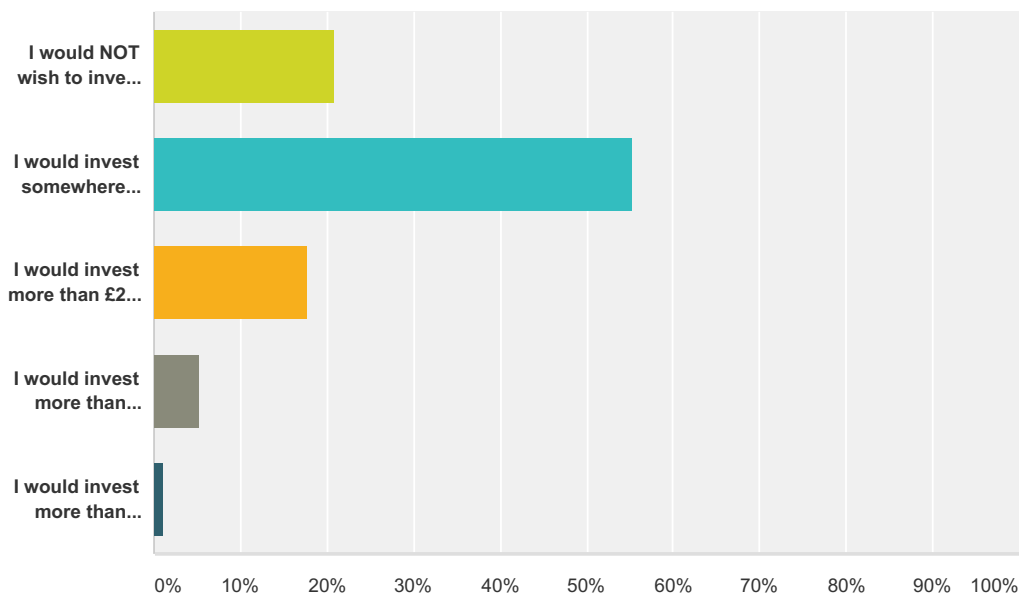

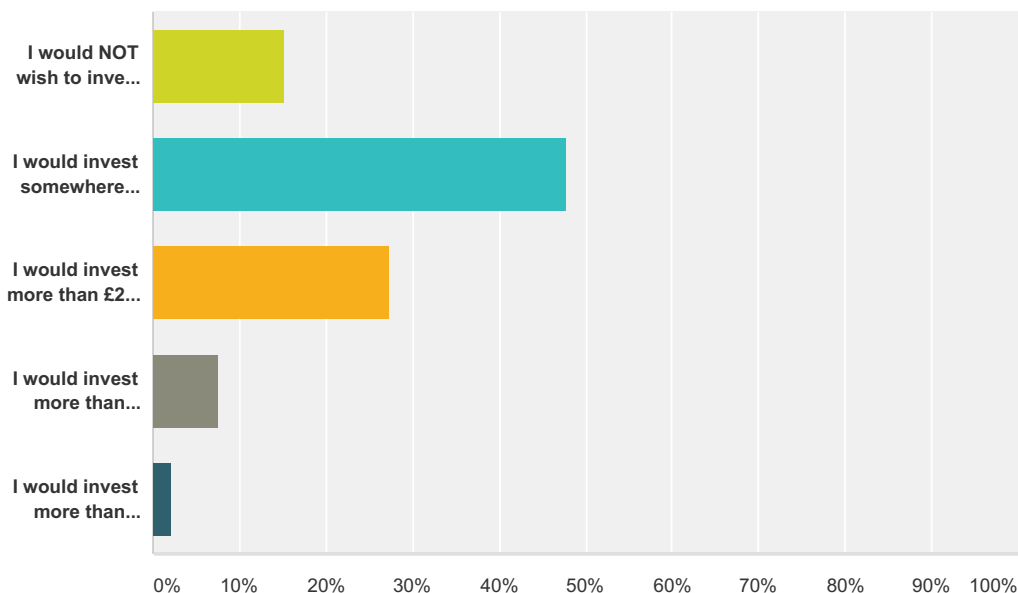

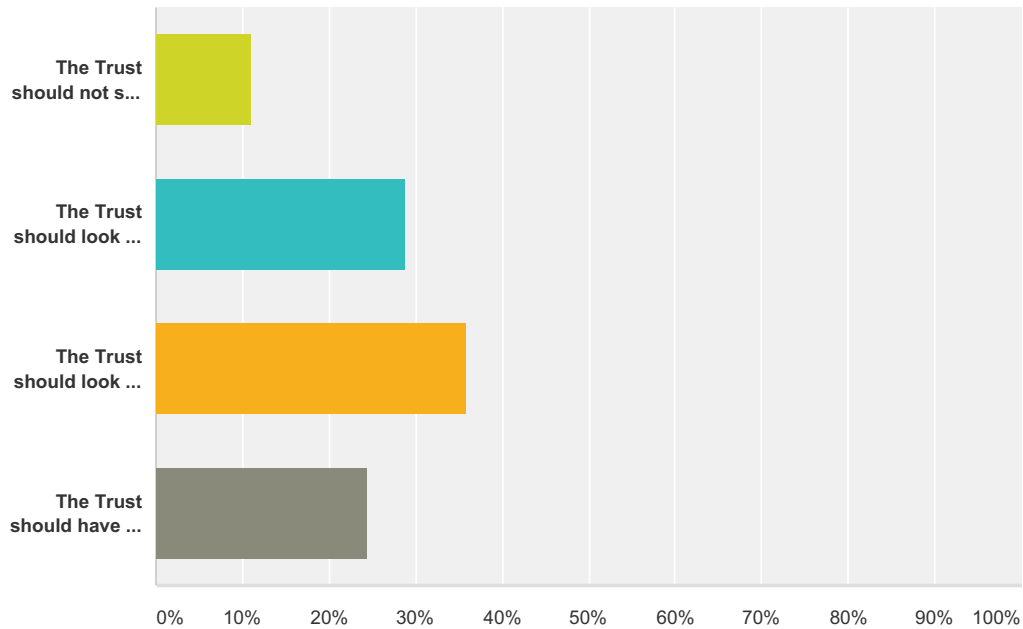

Q6 If the Supporters' Trust was to have some form of involvement in the running of the Football Club how would you prefer this to be achieved;

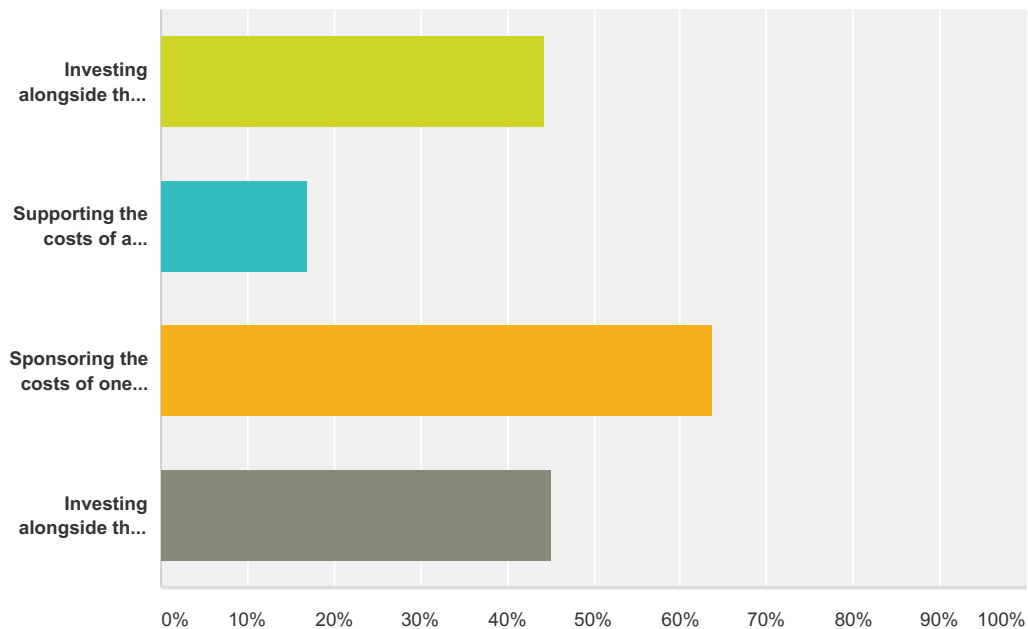

Q7 If the Supporters' Trust raised funds from the members and community, which of the following initiatives would you consider appropriate (tick all that apply)

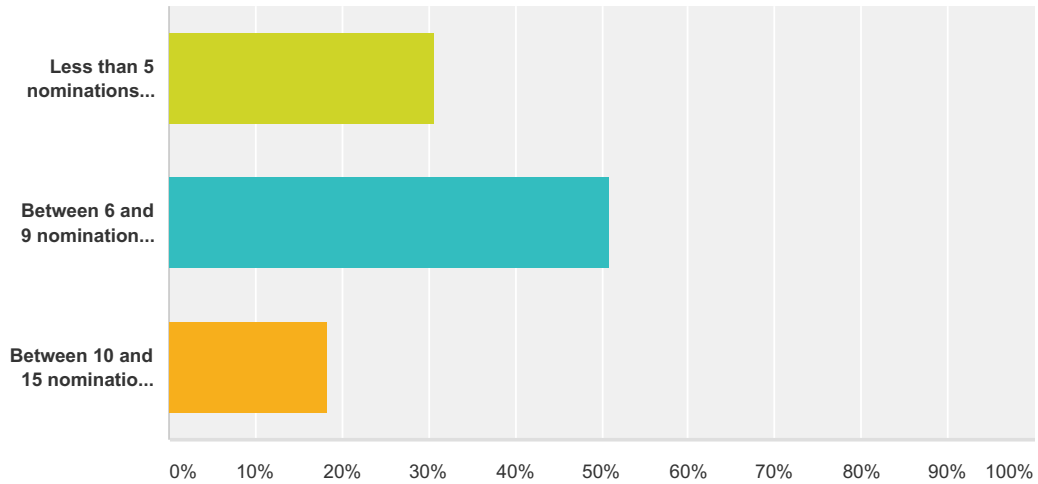

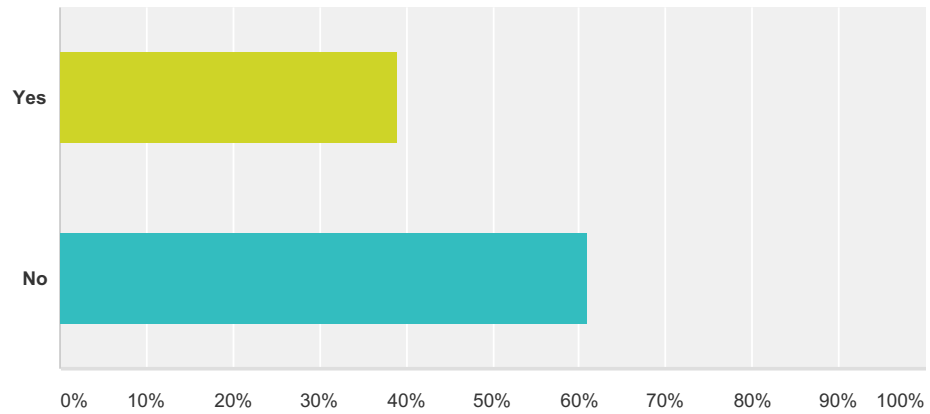

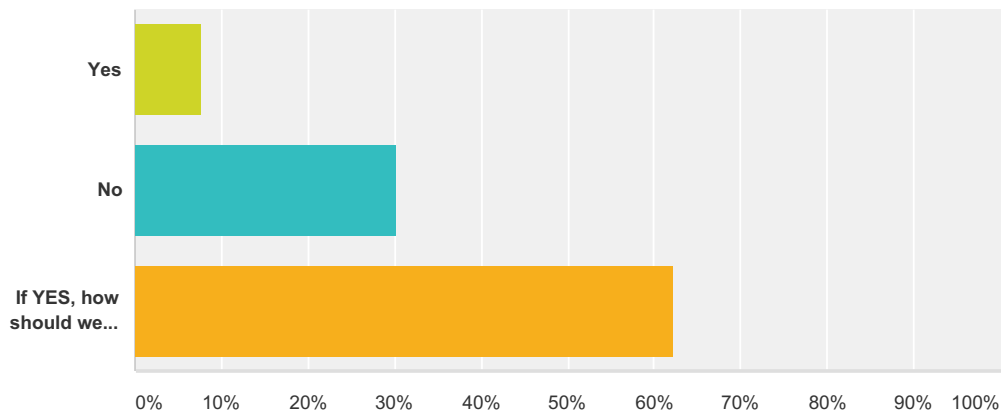
